- Degree in business administration, public administration, emergency management, or related field OR Degree in another discipline with education/training in emergency management; OR an equivalent combination of emergency management-related education and training. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Minimum three years of related experience including some experience in each of the following:
  - Leading emergency management recovery or response operations or equivalent experience in operations and,
  - Collaborating with external partners (e.g., First Nations, Local Governments) to build capacity, and,
  - Managing major projects or significant components of projects, and,
  - Preparing and delivering information to a wide variety of internal and external audiences.
