

Ministry of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness Multiple Locations (Hybrid)

Flexible work options are available; these positions may be able to work from home a few days a week subject to an approved Telework Agreement. The locations associated with each job posting varies, please see each position for more information. Applicants may be able to be based anywhere in BC.

These positions are two-year temporary opportunities. These temporary opportunities may be extended or become permanent. Employees of the BC Public Service must be located in BC at the time of employment.

Come build a rewarding career in our Provincial Community Recovery Program

The Ministry of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness (EMCR) is the lead coordinating agency in the provincial government for all emergency management activities.

The current opportunities below apply to applicants with a master's or bachelor's degree, diploma, or certificate focused in emergency management, community development, social services, natural resource management, project management, or a related field of education.

Manager, Community Recovery

This role maintains relationships with a wide network of internal and external partners to ensure the continual improvement of an integrated, interagency approach to achieve community emergency recovery outcomes.

Recovery Operation Officer

The Recovery Operations Officer negotiates and facilitates the coordination, oversight and reporting of multi-party recovery services in disaster zones throughout the province.

Community Recovery Coordinator

This role provides coordination, oversight and reporting of recovery operations in disaster zones throughout the Province. The Coordinator may be assigned to headquarters or to a specific event or location and is critical in ensuring teams are supported and information is flowing in a timely and effective manner.

Finance and Administration Clerk

The Finance and Administrative Clerk provides a variety of office administrative, and financial support services for the business unit.
