The BC Wildfire Service (BCWS) is the Province of BC's primary emergency response organization. It operates year-round to deliver its mandate for wildfire management and response to natural hazard emergencies. The BCWS operates provincially, delivering services through six fire centres, thirty-three zones and two provincial centres in Kamloops and Victoria.

The Wildfire Assistant is responsible for performing a core set of functions related to fire response and fire management. This position will supervise staff, including assigning work, developing and evaluating performance plans and approving leave. The Wildfire Assistant ensures crew readiness for fire response based on preparedness plan, standby requirements, fire weather forecasts and fire indices. This position assists with the maintenance of weather stations and communications infrastructure as required, monitors inventory levels and conducts various reviews to ensure inventory accuracy.

- Minimum 1 season of demonstrated supervisory experience.
