Qualifications for this role include:

- Degree in a field related to forestry, resource management or equivalent knowledge, plus two (2) years' recent, **related experience**; or,
- Technical diploma in a field related to forestry, resource management, or equivalent knowledge, plus four (4) years' recent, **related experience**; or,
- Secondary school graduation plus six (6) years' recent, **related experience**, or an equivalent combination of education and training.
- **Related experience** is defined as operations or other disciplines related to natural resource management.
- Minimum three (3) years of demonstrated supervisory experience.
- Demonstrated experience in program or project management.
- Demonstrated experience working on land and resource management issues.
- Preference may be given to candidates with senior Fireline Certification (ex. Type 2 or higher) or Incident Commander 3.
- Valid BC Class 5 Driver's Licence or equivalent.
